

# 10 THINGS TO DO IN VAL TARTANO

The happy position of Campo Tartano, the first village you come across whilst climbing uphill in Val Tartano, makes it the perfect place to embark on delightful and suggestive excursions featuring lesser-known itineraries at the valley entrance

"SENTIERO DEI PONTI"

Route of medium difficulty that connects Campo with the lower pastures of the consortium (3 hours)

BIRDWATCHING IN FRASNINO

Birdwatching route of average difficulty that connects

Campo with Frasnino (1,5 hours)

PATH 163 WITH 'PIZZO DELLA PRUNA'

Route of medium difficulty that connects 163
Campo with Tartano and passes through mountain pastures and the panoramic 'Pizzo della Pruna' (2 hours)

LA STRADA VEGIA
Route runs along Val Tartano and

Val Fabiolo (5 hours)



'ALTA VIA' OF VAL TARTANO

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Long route marked with AV flag that runs along the entire perimeter of the valley (2 days)

SOSTILA AND VAL FABIOLO
Route of average difficulty that connects Campo with the medieval hamlet of Sostila

BERNASCA LAKE

The lake and the refuge of Bernasca with bivouac shelter. Easy route. 2.5 hours from Campo

MUNT CÖCH BIVOUAC SHELTER

Easy route that leads to the panoramic bivouac shelter

THE TARTANO WOOD MUSEUM 
The wood: material of life in Valtartano

PORCILE LAKES

Classical route of average difficulty from Val Tartano to the three small mountain lakes (2 hours)

#### **RULES OF CONDUCT**

- maintain a safe distance of 2 metres between each person on the bridge
- maximum number of 100 people allowed at the same time
- it is strictly forbidden to go on the bridge in strong wind and thunderstorms
- it is strictly forbidden to run and jump on the bridge or cause it to swing
- it is strictly forbidden to lean over the railing
- it is strictly forbidden to throw objects from the bridge
- children must be constantly monitored by an adult while crossing the bridge
- Access onto the bridge in the event of snow is only permitted if authorized by the management (in such cases notices will be placed at the entrances)
- dogs must be kept on a leash at all times
- no transit for grazing animals
- it is strictly forbidden to cross the bridge with any type of vehicle
- the management bears no responsibility for any improper use of the facility

# THE 'BRIDGE IN THE SKY'

A direct connection between Campo and the pastures of Frasnino at an altitude of more than 140 metres.

It offers spectacular views of our dear mountains, the saddle of Campo Tartano, the imposing peaks and glaciers of the Rhaetian Alps, the wide, green valley of Tartano, Colombera dam, the fairy-tale pastures of Frasnino, the lower Valtellina which culminates in Lake Como, as well as unforgettable sunsets.
